## We look forward to welcoming you to the HSJ Digital Transformation Summit on 24-25 February.

The Summit team have been working hard to ensure we host the event in a covid safe environment, and I want to reassure you that keeping our delegates safe is our priority. The event has been organised to comply fully with the Government road map and we have introduced a number of other covid safety measures.

Here's what to expect and what to do before you attend:

### 1. Before you attend

All guests will be required to carry out a rapid lateral flow test. Tests should be carried out prior to arrival on the morning of the first day that you attend the summit.

- ▶ There is no facility to do the test at the venue so you must do the test before you arrive
- > You will only be permitted entry if you confirm you have carried out a test with a negative result
- ► If you test positive then please do not attend

**Covid Declaration:** please do not attend the event if you answer yes to any of the below questions.

- Have you tested positive for covid-19 in the last 7 days?
- Are you waiting for a covid-19 test or the results?
- Do you have any of the following symptoms: a new, continuous cough; a high temperature or fever; loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste?
- If you live with someone who has tested positive in the past 7-days and you are not fully vaccinated.

### 2. What to expect on arrival

Confirm you have taken a rapid lateral flow test in the last 24 hours with a negative result

you will be temperature checked and asked by staff if you answer no to all the covid declaration questions (refer to Section 1. before vou attend)

### Face covering -

**Registration** -

we are requesting that all attendees and staff wear a face covering when moving around the venue. Please inform staff if you are exempt

Your data - As part of the event planning, HSJ has a record of all attendee contact information, therefore, you will not be required to scan the NHS Track and Trace app

# 3. What to expect during the summit

- Please wear your face covering when moving around the venue
- Increased cleaning, sanitising of spaces and touchpoints
- On-site event safety team that can offer medical support if required

### **Temperature check**

- If your temperature is over 37.8C, you will not be permitted entry

Badges - For the security and safety of all delegates, please ensure you wear your badge throughout the event

- If you are staying more than 1-night, bedrooms will be refreshed upon request only
